After the Cairo Seminary Module, we traveled to Juba, South Sudan where we successfully conducted both Bible college and seminary level modules. The classes totaled **84 students** with 32 Bible college students and 52 seminarians. You will rejoice to know that at this present time we have two students, who are slated to graduate next October, that are actively engaged in church planting ministries in the city of Juba. Praise the Lord! He is still building His church. Pray for us as we consider other countries where we can establish module classes. Our God given goal is to train God called preachers who will carry the gospel to all nations (Matthew 28:19-20; 2 Timothy 2:2).
